July 6, 2020

Retaining wall on North Julian Street under construction.

Repair of 2001 Dump Truck box frame is completed. Final cost exceeded estimate that was previously approved by the board. Total cost is \$1768.71. Motion by Shuttlesworth, second by Paul to pay the current bill, motion carried.

Certificate of Deposit that matured was renewed for a period of 3 years.

Drainage pipe on W. 5th Street (Wesner Property) was inspected and found to be in good condition. The problem is the extension that was added on private property. Property Owner will be notified by J. Drum that is not the township responsibility.

Request for street light in the area of Zemco – W. Broad St. PPL will be contacted to obtain cost estimate for the installation of a new light.

Audit of Ivy Drum, Tax Collector was completed. Report dated 5-27-2020 was submitted and No Significant findings.

Harold Smith submitted his letter of resignation as secretary/treasurer for Williams Township effective July 24, 2020. Board accepted the resignation.
