RESIDENT/PROPERTY OWNER CONCERNS:

- Received concern from resident in Apple Manor regarding debris found in the ashes used for road conditions. The Township sent a "Notice" via Facebook advising residents of this concern and that we only accept coal ash remains/donations in our ash storage bin.
Update: Sent this "Notice" to the Williamstown Borough Authority for posting in their next quarterly newsletter. Also posted "Coal Ash Only" signs in the ash storage bin.
- Received complaint about property at the corner of Ray & Broad Streets having vehicles and equipment parked obstructing the view from intersection stop signs. **Update:** Sent two letters, January 30, and February 8, 2023, to the property owner regarding this concern and informing them of specific limits and restrictions.
- Received complaint about property at 602 West Market Street having debris blowing on the street and into adjacent properties. Sent letter to property owner on March 1, 2023.

CORRESPONDENCE:

- Received letter dated January 27, 2023, from the Upper Dauphin Council of Governments (COG) regarding their meeting held on January 19, where they discussed the health of EMS service in the Upper Dauphin Area. COG passed a motion to have the COG President form a committee to investigate the best ways to support and improve our local EMS services. COG is looking for participation on this committee from municipalities and local EMS.
- Received "Notice of Payment Liquid Fuels Tax Fund" from PENNDOT in the amount of \$43,279.60, will be paid on March 1, 2023.
- Received letters requesting donations to support local programs.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Review different options for purchase of the new Ford 350 Truck.
- No further update regarding dilapidated structure at 515 West Broad Street. Property owner contacted one of the contractors listed in our letter, dated December 7, 2022, regarding razing structure.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Received quotes for a new printer/copier from Richo USA, Inc., and Konica Minolta Business Solutions. Proceeding with Richo USA, Inc., to provide a 48-month lease unit.
