Road resurfacing of W. Broad St to Dayton St – awaiting scheduling by contractor.

State Route 209 “No Passing Zone” – Expect reply in 30 days

Roadwork for 2019 – Cold patch, repair pipe on North St., trim brush

Payment to Williamstown Development Organization authorized per 2019 Budget.

Complaints on several properties within the township. Letters have been sent to residents and in some cases no action. Township will coordinate with Williamstown Borough Authority and/or Engineer on action needed to proceed with legal action. (127 5th St.; 510 W. Market St.; 670 E. Market St.; and 834 W. Market St.

Letter request from Diane Kline requesting authority to have Fire Company stand by for the burning of weeds, etc at the rear of 512 W. Market St. Board denied request as not in conformance with provisions of Township Ordinance 7-101.

PA Auditor General Office completed audit of Liquid Fuels account for years 2017 and 2018. No findings were listed. Complete report will be furnished.
