

MINUTES

June 7, 2021

Board met in regular session with Ronald Paul, Harold Smith, Tom Shuttlesworth and Attorney Joe Kerwin. Also in Attendance was Jim Drum. Minutes from the previous meeting and Treasurers report were approved. Meeting was held under the Covid – 19 declared by Governor Wolf.

Correspondence received: Williamstown Readiness Center Storm Water Flow Waiver.

Clean up Day on May 8, 2021 totaled 71 trips and 60 tires from the Township residents. The Township received \$313.60 revenue from the scrap metal.

The complaint from the sewer odor at 640 West Market Street was investigated by the Borough Authority and was found to have a broken vent pipe. As per the Authority, the owner will have it repaired.

Property at 510 West Market Street . PPL was contacted and informed the Township that the power was de – energized in 2020. The Water/Sewer was terminated in December of 2020. The Township contacted Light-Heigel. They deemed that the property is unsafe and unsanitary.

Attorney Joe Kerwin will follow up on what information is required for the Judicial sale on 834 West Market St.

The Township is in need of a new Weed Trimmer and Hedge Trimmer. Motion to purchase by Harold Smith. Second by Tom Shuttlesworth.

The curve street sign on Broad St just before Tunnel St. was requested by Tom Shuttlesworth to be trimmed back for better visibility.

The Township will start the process of submitting the SAM Registration document to request funds from the American Rescue Plan.
