

MINUTES

WILLIAMS TOWNSHIP

Monday, October 3, 2022/7:00 PM

The Board met in regular session with the following present: Chairman/Supervisor, Ron Paul; Vice Chairman/Supervisor, Tom Shuttlesworth; Solicitor, Joe Kerwin, Esquire; Secretary/Treasurer, Beth Shuttlesworth; and Jack Schaeffer, Jr.

Minutes from the previous meeting and Treasurer's Report of September 6, 2022, were approved.

RESIDENT/PROPERTY OWNER CONCERNS:

- There were no Resident/Property Owner Concerns.

BUSINESS DISCUSSED:

- The Board of Supervisors offered Jack Schaeffer, Jr., the vacant Supervisor position. Mr. Schaeffer accepted the Board's offer. Motion was made by Tom Shuttlesworth, seconded by Ronald Paul, to approve hiring Jack Schaeffer, Jr., as a Supervisor.
- Update on concern for construction at 523 Greenfield Street; a representative from Light-Heigel & Associates visited the site and deemed the construction to be unsafe and to stop further construction. Supervisor, Ron Paul, will contact the resident, who provided the concern to the Township, with an update on status.
- Act 57 or 2022 Resolution was discussed; Mr. Kerwin recommended to "hold" on any action until further clarification.
- The 2022 Commonwealth state aid allocation supporting the Volunteer Fire Relief Association(s) (VFRA) of the fire company(ies) which serve the community, in the amount of \$5,460.63, was discussed. Motion made by Tom Shuttlesworth, seconded by Ron Paul, to release the funds to the Liberty Hose Company #1, Williamstown.
- The payment for re-paving of Dayton Street project was discussed; motion by Tom Shuttlesworth, seconded by Ron Paul, to release the funds for payment.

Being no further business to discuss, motion was made by Ron Paul, seconded by Tom Shuttlesworth, to adjourn the meeting at approximately 7:30 PM.
